The inspiration for Perry Farms Philadelphia Patch quilt block is an antique quilt by Fanny J Stallings Leonard Perry (1863-1918). Fanny and her first husband James Thomas Leonard, lived in the Sandy Creek area until his death in 1903. She then married Archibald Wiley Perry in 1913 and they lived on Perry Farm on Hickory Rock Road in Louisburg. The Philadelphia Patch quilt block pattern was published in several periodicals in the late 1800s and early 1900s. The antique quilt was made some time between 1880-1918.

Sarah Perry Mozingo is the sixth generation living on Perry Farm. Sarah inherited several chests of antique quilts from her parents: one of them being the Philadelphia Patch Quilt.

Sarah and her husband, Martin, live on this working farm and feel very fortunate to play a part in maintaining the homeplaces and original outbuildings.
